# CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 29:1-2; Ps. 33:1-3

Reader: *Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty Give unto the LORD glory and strength!*

**Congregation: Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.**

Reader: *Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous; for praise is comely for the upright.*

**Congregation: Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.**

Reader: *Sing unto him a new song*  
**Everyone: play skillfully on the strings with loud shouts!**

## CONFESSION OF SIN

*(After a time of silent confession, pray the following in unison)*

**Congregation:** *Almighty and most merciful Father, we have erred and strayed from Your ways like lost sheep. We have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts. We have offended against Your holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; and we have done those things which we ought not to have done; and there is no health in us. O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders. Spare those, O God, who confess their faults. Restore those who are penitent, according to Your promises declared unto mankind in Jesus Christ our Lord. And grant, O most merciful Father, for His sake, that we may hereafter live a godly, righteous, and sober life; to the glory of Thy holy Name. Amen."*

**Assurance of Pardon:** *"Jesus said... I am the resurrection, and the life; he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:"*

## CONFESSION OF FAITH

**Reader:** How can you repent and put your faith in Jesus Christ?

**Congregation:** *With God's help, I can acknowledge and turn from my sins, receive the gift of God's grace in Jesus Christ, and embrace the new life he freely gives me.<sup>1</sup>*

**Reader:** What should you do as the sign of your repentance and faith?

**Congregation:** *After receiving instruction in the faith, I should be baptized into the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, thus joining His body, the Church. If I have already been baptized, I should confess my sins, seek the guidance of a minister, affirm the promises made at my Baptism, and take my place as a member of the Church."<sup>2</sup>*
